Vocabulary	Meaning
artist	A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.
background	The part of a picture, scene, or design that forms a setting for the main figures or objects, or appears furthest from the viewer.
chalk	A white soft earthy limestone formed from the skeletal remains of sea creatures.
collage	A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing
dark	Not reflecting much light; approaching black in shade.
foreground	The part of a view that is nearest to the observer, especially in a picture or photograph.
layering	The action of arranging something in layers.
light	Reflecting much light; approaching white in shade or pale.
smudge	Cause (something) to become messily smeared by rubbing it.
texture	The feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or a substance.




