ENGLISH:

As writers we will use nouns, verbs and adjectives in our descriptive writing about space, new planets in faraway galaxies and amazing aliens. We will listen to a range of poetry, write our own countdown poem from 10-0 and recount our school trip to Beamish. A strong emphasis is placed on spelling and handwriting, as well as punctuation and grammar.

COMPUTING:

In computing we will develop our login and mouse skills. We will be looking at algorithms [step by step instructions] as a basic introduction to programming.

MATHEMATICS:

As mathematicians we will recap and extend our understanding of place value, number bonds and various mathematical symbols while deepening our understanding of multiplication, measurement and shape. We will also practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables daily.

HISTORY:

As historians we will look at Events beyond living memory that are significant nationally or globally. This will include a timeline of space events including the First Moon Landing and Neil Armstrong [significant individuals in the past]

SCIENCE:

As scientists we will learn about the varying habitats around the world and the animals / plants that live there. We will discover why some habitats and animals work well and why others wouldn't – can you imagine a camel living in the Arctic?

GEOGRAPHY:

As geographers we will look at the world from space. We will name the continents and oceans while recapping the countries and capitals of the United Kingdom.
