## Communication & Language

Listen to stories with and without pictures

Share my home – school news with others

Follow simple instructions

Learn and practise rhymes and songs for Harvest

Practise simple greetings e.g. good morning & good

afternoon

Retell past events in the correct order

#### **Literacy**

Book skills and stories
Individual reading
Small group phonic activities
Key words – the, I, go, to, no
Phase 2 Sounds – learning letters
Writing patterns and tracing
Writing our names
Brave writing [home-school news]
Use Talk for Writing to learn stories,
rhymes and poems

#### **Mathematics**

Learn how many children can work in each area of the class room
Join in with number rhymes
Count forwards and backwards
Make repeating patterns
2D shapes (circle, triangle, rectangle, hexagon & square) and shape pictures
Days of the week
Use every day words to describe position
Sort into sets and explaining why

Learn and talk about the season of
Autumn – autumn walk
Look closely at similarities and differences
See patterns and change in the world
around us
Work in our indoor – outdoor area
Use construction to build models
Learn how to login to school 360 eyfs
Use the "mouse" to create a picture

## Expressive Arts & Design

Sing simple songs and rhymes
Listen to different types of music
Take part in our Harvest Assembly
Engage in small world and role-play
activities
Explore different textures - making collages
Tell stories through play/drama
