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| <p><b>ENGLISH:</b> Children will cover various aspects of fiction, non-fiction, poetry, spelling, punctuation &amp; grammar [SPAG] during the term.</p> <p><b>MATHEMATICS:</b> Children will cover various aspects of number &amp; place value, addition &amp; subtraction, multiplication &amp; division, fractions, measurement, geometry &amp; statistics during the term.</p> | <p><b>SCIENCE:</b><br/>(Living things – digestive system, teeth and food chains)<br/>Humans and animals have many different types of teeth. Our teeth will change with age. So, the teeth you have when you are a baby aren't the same as the ones you will have as an adult. Bacteria can ruin teeth and stop them from doing their job. We are going to learn all about it!</p> | <p><b>COMPUTING:</b><br/>The children will explore software development this term. They will discover what software is and use various programmes to explore software programmes and have a go at designing their own, using a range of programmes and apps on the computers.</p>                    |
| <p><b>HISTORY:</b><br/><i>What did the Romans do for us?</i><br/>The children will explore the Roman empire and its impact on the United Kingdom. They will develop an understanding of world history and the stories that surround it.</p>   | <p><b>GEOGRAPHY:</b><br/>Local Area Study:<br/>The children will explore their local area to develop an understanding of our location within the United Kingdom and beyond.</p>   | <p><b>LANGUAGES [FRENCH]:</b><br/>Children will listen and respond to French. This half term we will be focussing on the topic of 'Getting to know you' where the children will learn to describe and answer questions about themselves and others.</p>  |

| <p><b>P.H.S.E. EDUCATION:</b><br/>Our focus is on democracy. This will include 'what democracy means as well as how the system of voting and elections works in the UK. They use ideas from these as a starting point for developing their own designs.</p>   | <p><b>DESIGN &amp; TECHNOLOGY:</b><br/>Seasonal food - The children will concentrate on the following questions: Why are certain foods in season at different times of year? Why is it good to eat seasonal food? How can we include seasonal food in a healthy, varied diet?</p>                    |
