<b>Helping your child.</b> One method of helping your child learn their spelling is <b>'Look, cover, write, check'</b> Children look at a word and sound it out, cover it, practice writing it and then check it. If you wish to challenge your child even further you could ask them to say a sentence using the word or even write a sentence and then try to improve it.
