Helping your child.

One method of helping your child learn their spellings is 'Look, cover, write and check'. Children look at a word and sound it out, cover it, practice writing it and then check it.

If you wish to challenge your child even further you could ask them to say a sentence using the word or even write a sentence and then try and improve it.
