COVID 19 Updates

- Should any of your children test positive following a PCR test, I would like to remind you of the contact number to inform the school immediately. We ask that you: Text 07594379089 with the name of the child and the date of the test result. (This number should not be used for any other reason)
 - The close contacts of the child who tested positive self isolate.

If we receive any notifications of a positive result within your child's bubble we will aim to inform families as soon as possible as your child will be required to self-isolate. We highly recommend that all families have a plan in place should you be contacted.
