### Tablets

Tablets are mobile, touchscreen computers that work in a similar way to smartphones. They are slim, lightweight and portable and can be used to access the internet, download and use apps, read eBooks and many other things. A tablet has less memory than a laptop but a faster start up time. Keyboards are generally used on the screen though it is possible to add an external keyboard. Examples of tablets include the iPad, the Microsoft Surface, Blackberry Playbooks and a range of Android devices from manufacturers such as Samsung.
