Reading treat re-launch

As we are now confident all children have the opportunity to read at least 5 times per week despite books needing to be stored for three days prior to recirculation we are relaunching our 'Reading Treat' incentive.

Children should read for at least 20 minutes per day and we encourage children to write in their own diary where possible. 
