
Vocabulary	Meaning
artefact	An object that is made by a person, especially something of historical or cultural interest.
Buddha	The person on whose teachings the Buddhist religion is based.
Buddhism	An Asian religion based on the teaching of Siddhartha Gautama.
followers	A person who supports and admires a particular person or set of ideas.
meditate	To think deeply, usually in silence, especially for religious reasons.
parable	A short story that teaches a moral or spiritual lesson.
ritual	A series of actions that are always performed in the same way, especially as part of a religious ceremony.
shrine	A place where people come to worship because it is connected with a holy person or event.
Siddhartha Gautama	Buddha.
symbol	A person, an object, an event that represents a quality or situation.
Temple	A building used for the worship of a god or gods, especially in religions other than Christianity.
worship	The practice of showing respect for God or a god, by saying prayers, singing with others, etc.; a ceremony for this.


