Vocabulary	Meaning
<b>artefact</b>	An object that is made by a person, especially something of historical or cultural interest.
<b>Buddha</b>	The person on whose teachings the Buddhist religion is based.
<b>Buddhism</b>	An Asian religion based on the teaching of Siddhartha Gautama.
<b>followers</b>	A person who supports and admires a particular person or set of ideas.
<b>meditate</b>	To think deeply, usually in silence, especially for religious reasons.
<b>parable</b>	A short story that teaches a moral or spiritual lesson.
<b>ritual</b>	A series of actions that are always performed in the same way, especially as part of a religious ceremony.
<b>shrine</b>	A place where people come to worship because it is connected with a holy person or event.
<b>Siddhartha Gautama</b>	Buddha.
<b>symbol</b>	A person, an object, an event that represents a quality or situation.
<b>Temple</b>	A building used for the worship of a god or gods, especially in religions other than Christianity.
<b>worship</b>	The practice of showing respect for God or a god, by saying prayers, singing with others, etc.; a ceremony for this.

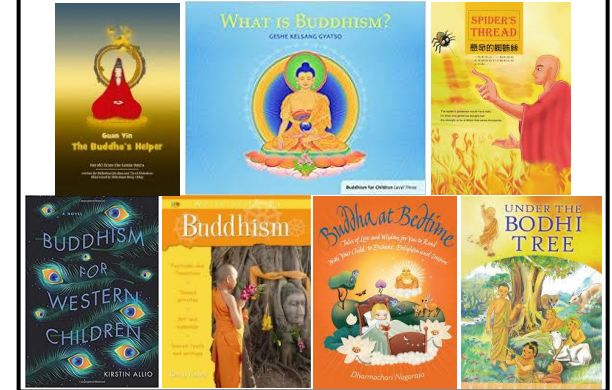

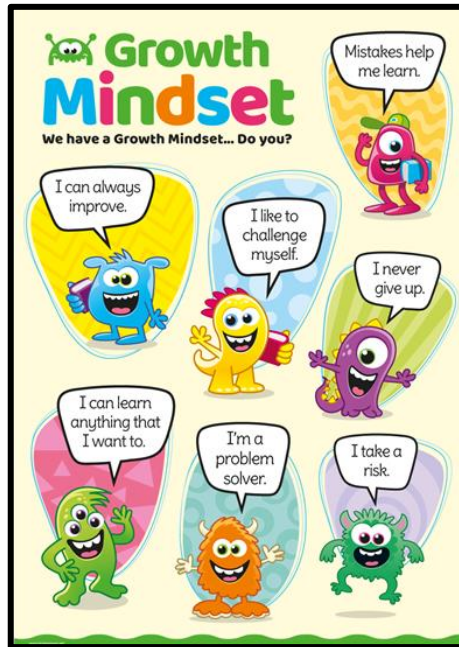
