ENGLISH: Aiming to inspire children to read and write like an author, English will be taught through a love of books and will cover various aspects of fiction, non-fiction, poetry, spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) during the term.	MATHEMATICS: Will be taught in an exciting, motivating and interactive way for children to become competent mathematicians developing skills in mental calculation, using and applying number, measures (time and clocks), shape and space and data handling. LANGUAGES [FRENCH]: Building on our knowledge of France, children will be learning set phrases to talk about themselves and ask others for personal information. We will also be learning to count to twenty and simple weather phrases.
