

RE – Year 4 – spring 2 – Why is Easter important to Christians?

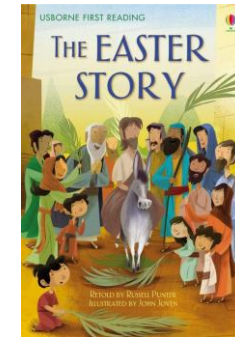
Vocabulary

Palm Sunday	The Sunday before Easter when Jesus came to Jerusalem.
