

What I will be learning

Knowledge

Can you think of times when we give and receive presents? Understand there are lots of different times we give presents, such as Christmas and birthdays or to show someone we care.

Who brought baby Jesus gifts and why? - The wise men knew Jesus was special so they wanted to give gifts to celebrate his importance.

What gifts did the wise men give to Jesus and what gifts might a Christian might give to a baby?

Understand that the wise men brought Jesus gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh. Talk about presents they might have received as a baby.

What presents can be given that you can't see?

Discuss why giving presents is an important idea for Christians as a way of showing someone you care for them. You can give someone a hug, be their friend or help them.

Why do Christian's believe that Jesus is God's gift to the world? Christians believe God gave him as a gift to the world as Jesus brought love, peace, joy and hope to all the world.
