

E-Safety: New Technologies & Possible Risks

One in five secondary pupils checks social media in the middle of the night, study finds
Checking social media at night means that teenagers are constantly tired at school, academics say.

Six in ten parents say they would let their children lie about their age online to access social media sites
A survey by Aviva also found a third of parents allow their children to use the internet without parental controls.

Police warn of rise in children bullied by sext

Police are likely to see a rise in cases involving children bullying and threatening each other by posting naked images online.

NSPCC warns of the return of the 'salt and ice challenge' that sees teenagers hospitalised
