What are kids doing?

Before they've even learnt to read, most can navigate through devices to play games and watch cartoons. By the time they reach the age of 8 over one in three children own their own smartphone and 55% have their own Tablet. YouTube is an increasingly popular destination and an alternative to TV as over 70% of 5 - 11s use the platform to watch cartoons, funny videos or their favourite TV show.

What risks do they face?

The internet can expose children to things that they may not be ready for such as violent content, extreme ideas and adult content either by accident or through an intentional search. As they start to communicate with others through gaming or social networks there's the temptation to overshare information that could lead to incidences of cyberbullying or put them at risk of being approached by those that may wish them harm.
