

## **Shilbottle First School Pupil Premium Reporting to Parents**

Pupil Premium Grant (PPG) Allocation for 2015/16 is: £14,520 for vulnerable children and £3600 for Forces children.

Number of pupils and pupil premium grant (PPG) received: 11 children

Total number of pupils on roll 115

Total number of pupils eligible for PPG is 15 children

### **Principles**

- We strive to ensure that teaching and learning opportunities meet the needs of all of our pupils.
- We ensure that appropriate provision is made for pupils who belong to vulnerable groups, this includes ensuring that the needs of socially disadvantaged pupils are adequately assessed and addressed.
- In making provision for socially disadvantaged pupils, we recognise that not all pupils who receive free school meals will be socially disadvantaged.
- We also recognise that not all pupils who are socially disadvantaged are registered or qualify for free school meals, these children still need support.
- Pupil premium funding will be allocated following a needs analysis which will identify priority classes, groups or individuals.
- Providing small group work with experienced teaching assistant focused on overcoming gaps in learning, e.g. booster groups
- Intervention strategies e.g. Talk Boost RWI, precision teaching, Big Maths Drivers, Dynamo Maths, 1-1 / 1-2 / 1-3 support
- Additional teaching and learning opportunities at lunchtimes and after school eg homework club, other after school provision
- Teaching assistant support to raise attainment in Y1/2 in phonics and reading – creating smaller ability based groups in RWI.
- All our work through the pupil premium will be aimed at accelerating expected progress.
