

Water Bottles

Children drinking juice from their water bottles can potentially affect their teeth in later years. Therefore any child found to have juice in their bottles will have this disposed of and replaced with water. It would also be greatly appreciated, particularly for our younger children, if you could ensure they are able to open their bottles independently.

Threadworm

A parent has very kindly reported to the school they think their child may have threadworm. Please be aware these are often spread through children not washing their hands thoroughly, therefore, you may want to reinforce the importance of good hygiene routines. Treatment is usually available from the pharmacist and we will be advising the local pharmacist that there may be an increased demand.
