

# **New Classes for September 2021 (reminder)**

As I am sure you will appreciate the plans outlined are subject to change as they are dependent on Government Guidance for how schools can operate in September which may not be released before the end of the academic year. Therefore we ask that you check your emails before school reopens in September for any new updates. At present, hoping that schools can return to operating normally, classes will be structured as follows:

Miss Harrison: New Reception all day and new Year 1 mornings only.

Mrs Kelly: New Year 2 all day and new Year 1 afternoons only.

Mrs Hunt: New Year 3 only. Mr Skirving: New Years 4 and 5.

Mr Phillips: New Year 6.

Other arrangements such as start/end times and collection/drop off points will remain the same until we have confirmation that we are no longer required to keep children divided into separate bubbles.

### **KEEP SAFE (reminder)**

We have been fortunate (and lucky) that we have not been required to send any bubbles home for a two week isolation period so far during the pandemic. However, there has been a marked increase in reported cases in Northumberland over the past few days. Therefore please continue to follow the guidance of socially distancing and not meeting indoors with groups of greater than six so we can continue to keep children in school safely.
