



Pupil Code of Conduct - Remote Learning

When using Google Classroom, I will:

- ✓ follow my teacher's instructions from the class stream and videos
- ✓ follow the daily timetable of work on Google Classroom where possible.
- ✓ Complete my tasks on my own as well as I possibly can
- ✓ use the comment features to ask my teacher questions about the work that has been set
- ✓ not forward or share links that are inappropriate.

When using Zoom, I will:

- ✓ keep my microphone muted unless the teacher asks me to speak
- ✓ pay attention, listen well and stay focused for the whole session
- ✓ not eat during a live session
- ✓ be on time and fully dressed for live sessions
- ✓ not take photos or videos of a live session
- ✓ keep my personal information private
- ✓ not send private messages to my friends during live sessions
- ✓ be kind, sensible and show respect at all times

Parent agreement - Remote Learning

When pupils are learning remotely, they may be joining 'live' sessions. Their teachers may be streaming the session from school or from another location, depending on the circumstances. Our expectation is that pupils continue to follow the full curriculum, working both independently and with the support of their teacher. We expect pupils to behave respectfully and work hard. We value your support in ensuring that your child learns safely and helps to keep others safe.

We request that parents uphold the following principles. As a parent/carers I will:

- ✓ ensure, as far as possible, that my child can access their learning in a quiet, safe and appropriate environment
- ✓ where possible, be situated where I can see/hear my child's online sessions
- ✓ be aware that I may be visible on camera and ensure I am dressed in an appropriate manner
- ✓ encourage my child to pay attention during assemblies and class meetings and to complete tasks set by the teachers, as far as possible
- ✓ ensure that no element of an online session is recorded by my child, myself or family members
- ✓ avoid trying to communicate with the teacher during a live session, as this will disrupt the learning of all pupils
- ✓ avoid making derogatory comments, or sharing any material on social media that could identify other children, the school or staff
- ✓ not send inappropriate, abusive or aggressive messages to school staff
- ✓ refrain from using the class stream/ live comment feed to communicate with the teacher; this is for pupils to use. Parents are able to use ClassDojo to contact the teacher
- ✓ report any concerns that I have about my child's learning with appropriate staff at school.
