Vocabulary	Meaning
artist	A person who creates paintings or drawings as a profession or hobby.
background	The part of a picture, scene, or design that forms a setting for the main figures or objects, or appears furthest from the viewer.
charcoal	A hard, black substance similar to coal that can be used as fuel or, in the form of sticks, as something to draw with
collage	A piece of art made by sticking various different materials such as photographs and pieces of paper or fabric on to a backing.
figure	The shape of the human body, or a person.
industrial	An area of land with a lot of industry and factories.
landscape	A view or picture of the countryside, or the art of making such pictures.
perspective	The way that objects appear smaller when they are further away and the way parallel lines appear to meet each other at a point in the distance.
seascape	A painting of a view of the sea.
shades	The parts of a picture or painting that the artist has made slightly darker than the other parts.



Who is L. S. Lowry?

Laurence Stephen Lowry was born in 1887 and died in 1976. He was an English artist famous for paintings about urban life.

What does perspective mean?

The way that objects appear smaller when they are further away and the way parallel lines appear to meet each other at a point in the distance.

How and why do you create different shades of colour?

A shade is a mixture of a colour with black. Artists use shading to show light and shadows. When artists make the colour of what they are painting darker, it makes it look further away from the light and three-dimensional.

Tell me about when you created a background in another medium.

For the Great Fire of London I used chalk and tissue paper behind black silhouettes.
