Thank you for ensuring all children returned to school with their PE kit. As the weather becomes increasingly changeable this may lead to last minute changes to the PE timetable and therefore we highly recommend children bring PE either each Monday and take them home each Friday or leave their kits in school for the half term. All black or grey jogging trousers and hooded tops may also be advisable for colder weather.

Car Park

We ask that the car park is not used as a short cut home or to access the bicycle storage areas. Staff and visitors may be reversing cars in this area and we are trying to avoid any accidents. The bicycle storage areas can be accessed via the same gate the children enter school each morning. If you are asking family members to collect children at the end of the day it would be appreciate if you could also ask them to avoid using the car park area.
