Internet Safety Day

This week has also seen internet safety day which has enabled us to repeat our reminders of how to be safe when online. As a school this is something we do on a consistent basis each time the children need to access online information. Obviously, as a school the filters and blocked websites are thoroughly monitored by both ourselves and Northumberland County Council. However, we are aware that a vast majority of our children have their own devices at home. During a whole school assembly we were taken aback by the number of children who claim (and we appreciate this may not reflect reality) that they have unmonitored access to the internet at home. We cannot emphasise enough the importance of ensuring adults at home are monitoring their children's use of devices. A few questions you may want to consider are: When did I last check my child's browsing history? Which social media platforms do they access? How confident am I that my child is not talking to strangers online? When did I last ask my child about what they would do if they experienced bullying or felt in danger when online? Is the content my child is accessing age appropriate? Has my child ever shared their personal details with someone online? Who sees my child on webcam? Remember keeping our children safe is everyone's responsibility.
